Your first day

The International Summer Camp & Junior Golf Academy starts on Sunday, 15 July 2012 or Sunday, 29 July 2012. You can arrive at the Lyceum Alpinum from 11:00 am onwards. At 15:00 you and your parents/guardian are invited to a welcome party, where you will have the opportunity to meet all the other participants, your supervisors and the teachers.

Junior Golf Academy

For those taking part in the golf programme there are 3 hours of personalised golf instruction a day. Participants work on their individual skills, their technique and widen their knowledge of the game. Groups of max. 10 participants are taught by professional instructors, all of them full members of the Swiss Professional Golfers Association (Swiss PGA), specialised and experienced in teaching golf to children. All are welcome – players with handicap as well as beginners. We also offer the possibility to obtain the licence to play on the golf course (PR).

The Lyceum Alpinum Zuoz has lots to offer

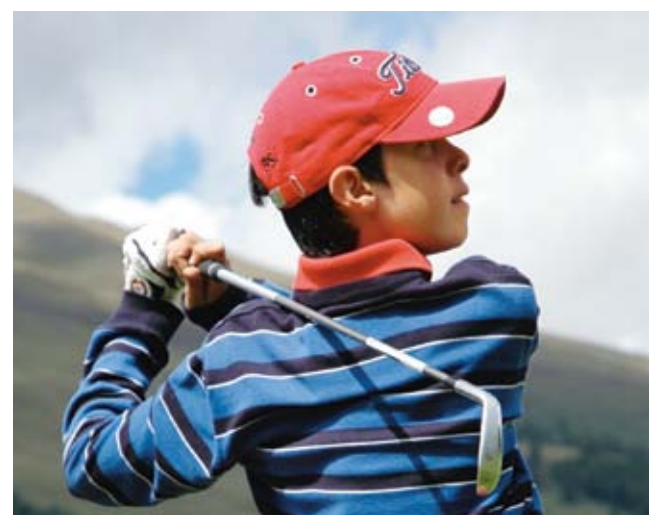
You will be accommodated in our study bedrooms and will have full use of our extensive sports fields, tennis courts, gym and fitness centre.

Supervision and care

The Engadin is a paradise for youngsters, where they can enjoy the great outdoors. Participants are looked after round-the-clock, and during the whole of their stay in Zuoz they are under the care and supervision of teachers and professional activity leaders.

New: Stay for four weeks!

Students can now stay in the International Summer Camp for both camps with the

following option: Camp 1 in the Junior Golf Academy, Camp 2 in the sports programme. An extra CHF 250.– will be charged for weekend supervision between Camp 1 and Camp 2.

Payments must be made by bank transfer to one of our accounts. You will receive a confirmation and a detailed invoice from our Administration Office. The parents are required to settle the amount stated in the invoice within the stipulated period of notice.

Admission is completed upon receiving payment.

Fees are all inclusive and cover 15 lessons of classroom tuition plus four supervised study periods per week, learning and study materials, two weeks accommodation in a single or double room, all meals and beverages, weekly laundering of bedding and personal clothing, 3 to 4 hours per day of sport or golf lessons, all evening activities, weekend programmes, personalised language course and golf report, photos, excursions and entertainment.

Cancellation

In case of illness or other valid reasons, you will need to provide a written claim and a medical certificate.

Insurance

Parents/guardians are responsible for taking out suitable health and accident insurance as well as third party liability cover for the duration of the International Summer Camp & Junior Golf Academy, including travelling to and from Zuoz.
