This dress code is binding for all boarders and day students at the Lyceum Alpinum Zuoz.

A Formal dress

Formal occasions either at school or off campus (e.g. special dinners, theatre, concerts) and on the instructions of the boarding houses:

Boys

School blazer: dark blue
Shirt: white, pale blue
Elegant dark grey or dark blue trousers
Black leather shoes
School tie

Girls

School blazer: dark blue
Blouse: white, pale blue, pink or top with sleeves
Classical trousers or skirt: black, dark grey or dark blue
Pumps or sandals

B Casual-elegant

Theatre, concerts at school, trips with the school teams and on the instructions of the boarding houses:

Boys

School blazer: dark blue
Shirt/polo shirt: white, pale blue, striped
Chinos, smart jeans
Casual but neat shoes allowed
School tie (according to instructions)

Girls

School blazer: dark blue
Blouse/polo: white, pale blue, pink, striped
Chinos, smart jeans
Casual but neat shoes allowed

C Everyday school wear

General impression: neat and tidy, clean, respectable.

Polo shirts, normal shirts, blouses, T-shirts. School- or other pullover, as required, own choice of long trousers, worn at hip level.

But:

- no bermudas
- no jogging trousers outside sports classes
- no T-shirts with provocative messages
- no bare mid-riffs
- no see-through or low-cut tops
- no tops with "spaghetti" straps
- no torn jeans
- no camouflage prints
- no visible underwear
- no beachwear
- no flipflops during school time or in the dining hall
- no headgear during school time or in the dining hall.
