Language Course

English, German and French classes (A0 – C1)

The English, German and French classes are for non-native speakers of the chosen languages and are offered from beginner to advanced levels.

Although all languages skills are introduced into the classes, for example listening, reading, speaking and writing, the focus of the classes is on communicative language learning. This means that the children learn in a non-threatening, highly motivating environment, usually working in pairs or groups to build up their confidence

As the classes have students of mixed nationalities, children have the opportunity to share their ideas and to develop a better knowledge of other cultures. Grammar and vocabulary – extension is still integral part of the lessons, with writing being carried out primarily in the homework sessions.

English and German with an academic focus (B1+ - C1/2)

This course is for non-native English/German speakers who need to improve their skills to succeed in a mainstream English/German classroom.

The course should also be helpful for children taking tests. Although all academic skills (reading, writing, listening and speaking) and remedial grammar will be included, the emphasis will be on Academic Writing, with the goal being to improve the learners' English/German composition skills, which are vital for success in English/German-speaking schools.
