## 1. Arrival

We would like to recommend that you bring your child/children on the first Monday of each week to the Lyceum Alpinum Zuoz. It will give you the chance to meet the Camp Manager and the teacher.

The children will be welcomed by the Camp Manager of the Junior Day Camp and their teachers and brought to the classrooms.

If your child is unable to attend one day please inform the Camp Manager of the Junior Day Camp, Ms Camille (see point 7).

Each Friday we would like to show you what your children did during the week, so we invite you to a small aperitif and talk together from 15.30-16.00 at our Camps. If you cannot take part, please inform the Camp Manager.

## 3. Programme

A detailed weekly programme will be sent to you two weeks before the Junior Day Camp starts.

## 4. Pick-up Service

We will pick-up/bring you children each day from your home to the school.

Please fill in the enclosed Form 1 if you desire this service. Two week before the Junior Day Camp, we will send you the pick-up schedule of your child. The pick-up/bring home schedule could be changed daily.

Our pick-up service is free of charge.

## 5. Clothes and School Materials

Zuoz is located at 1,750 metres above sea level and enjoys a sunny high-alpine climate

The following clothing is essential:

- shoes (sneakers)
- hat
- sunglasses
- sun cream
- raincoat
- fleece pullover

We will provide the necessary school material.

## 6. Language Lessons

The language courses are taught by academia Zurich. So that we can evaluate your son or daughter's language ability and place everyone in the appropriate class, we need your help: Could you please ask your child to complete our **Online placement test no later than 31 May 2019**.

- The test gets progressively harder. When your child can no longer answer the questions, the test should be sent. **The writing must be done.**
- If your child is **complete beginner**, please send an email to [summercamp@lyceum-alpinum.ch](mailto:summercamp@lyceum-alpinum.ch) to explain that your child **cannot do the test**.

Tests must be completed by the camp participant, **without** any **help** or checking from other people.

## 7. The person responsible for the Junior Day Camp during the camp weeks

For the pick-up service we will have Mr Brandon in charge. He will welcome and take care of your children during the bus transfers.

## 8. Regulations/Conduct

Our school reserves the right to send home anyone whose behaviour is incompatible with our school rules.

## 9. Insurance Coverage

The Lyceum Alpinum Zuoz does not offer insurance coverage. Parents are responsible for organising suitable health and accident insurance as well as third party liability cover for the period of their child's stay in Zuoz, including their travelling time to and from Zuoz.

## 10. Medical Assistance

Our nurse will be available around the clock and the school doctor is available for medical visits. In serious cases, we will take the children to the regional hospital in Samedan.
