On the road in this African country, we will be visiting schools and remote villages. At every stop we will read stories from books and bring them to life through imaginative games and painting activities. In doing so we will make a meaningful contribution to improving the literacy rates in Malawi.

A typical week day (Monday to Friday) will look as follows:

- 07:00 – 08.30 Breakfast and departure
- 09:00 – 12.30 Educational activities at different schools
- 13:00 Lunch
- 14:00 – 17:00 Various activities:  
Building schools and providing school meals, empowerment programmes, tree planting, water management, to name just a few



Accommodation during the week at Fisherman’s Rest, a beautifully located lodge, south of Blantyre, in simple bungalows.

At the weekends, there will be excursions such as going on a safari and a trip to Blue Zebra Island Lodge on Lake Malawi.

We estimate the total cost at between CHF 5’800 and CHF 6’800, depending on the number of participants, all inclusive.
