

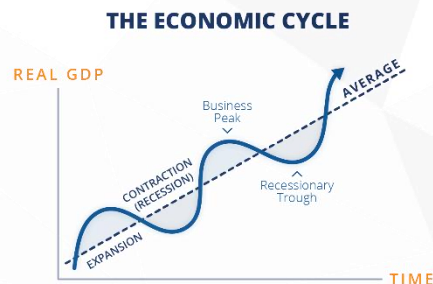
EF Economics & Law
