The **application fee** is payable upon the submission of an application. This fee is non-refundable regardless of the admissions outcome. The application fee must be paid prior to admissions testing and offer.

The **Legacy Fund “Stipendienstiftung”** is a one-time contribution to the scholarship programme which helps support partial scholarships for students demonstrating excellence in academics or sport. Each family’s contribution leaves a lasting impact—helping shape the future for generations of Zuoz students.

The **deposit** reserves a student’s place. A non-interest-bearing deposit invoice will be sent with the enrolment contract. This will be credited with the final bill when the student leaves the school.

Sibling Discounts: For families with more than one child enrolled at the Lyceum Alpinum Zuoz at the same time, we are pleased to offer a 10% sibling discount. The full tuition fee is applied to the eldest child, while each additional child receives a 10% reduction on their fees. Please note that this discount is only applicable when two or more children are attending the school simultaneously.

SUPPLEMENTAL CHARGES

Single room charge: Families may indicate a preference for a single room during the application process. A single room supplement charge of CHF 15,000 will be applied to the annual fees and will be billed separately. However, single rooms **cannot be guaranteed**, and all final room and house assignments are made at the discretion of the school. Parents will be notified of housing and room assignments two weeks prior to the start of the academic year. Priority is given to students in Grades 10–12 and to those who are currently enrolled.

Personalised Learning Coaching: This structured academic support programme is offered to students who would benefit from enhanced, individualised learning strategies. It caters to a broad range of student needs—from managing dyslexia or ADHD to extending learning for high-achievers.

To ensure flexibility and impact, our coaching programme is offered in three tiers based on the level of intervention required. The fees associated with each tier reflect the intensity and frequency of support provided, matched to individual needs of the student needs. The needs of the student will be reviewed at the end of each semester.

Tier 1 – Mild Support: For students who need short-term or occasional help, this level provides targeted academic or ESL support in one-on-one or small group settings. Progress is monitored closely, and teachers collaborate to reinforce learning in the classroom.

Tier 2 – Moderate Support: Designed for students who require more regular and structured help, Tier 2 includes ongoing academic or ESL sessions with tailored strategies. Goals are set for each student, and progress is reviewed regularly. Our Learning Support teacher works closely with classroom teachers and parents to ensure consistent support and communication.

Tier 3 – Intensive Support: For students whose needs go beyond classroom differentiation, this level provides frequent, individualized assistance with academic and/or ESL learning. Support involves one-on-one sessions, personalized planning, and continuous tracking of progress. The Learning Support team coordinates closely with classroom teachers and maintains regular communication with parents. Plans are adapted as the student's needs evolve, within the scope of the school's resources.

A student's assigned tier may be adapted at any point during the academic year in response to evolving needs, following a review by the academic team. Any changes to the support level will be made in consultation with and with the approval of the parents or guardians.

Any student requiring support beyond the levels indicated will be quoted a price independent of the above.

THE TUITION FEES INCLUDE:

- Accommodation and pastoral care
- Meals & Snacks on campus
- Curriculum lessons in all compulsory subjects
- Care via our School Health Centre and School Psychologists
- Extracurricular Activities Programme (ECA)
- All year mountain pass (incl. Ski pass)
- College Counselling
- School books
- Activities associated with Community Weekends
- Participation in cultural and sporting events to represent the school

NOT INCLUDED IN THE TUITION FEES:

- Insurance premiums
- Costs for medical treatment and medication not covered by insurance
- University application fees
- Individual costs for project weeks (Matura/German Intensive Year)
- Non-compulsory trips & excursions
- Visa and residence permit fees
- Transfers to/from the airport
- Additional costs as listed below

The prices of the main costs are typically adjusted for inflation according to the Swiss National Consumer Price Index and other requirements at the beginning of the school year 2027/28. The price invoiced is the binding price stated here in CHF, which is converted into Euro at the foreign exchange buying rate of the day (of the Graubündner Kantonalbank) incl. 2% safety margin when invoicing.

Costs for trips, excursions and journeys will be invoiced with a handling fee of 5% and Value Added tax of 8.1%.

Tuition & Fee Payments:

Choosing the right school for your child is an important decision, and we want to make sure our financial conditions are clear and transparent. Please find below an overview of how fees are structured for both returning and new families.

New Families: To confirm and secure a place for your child, new families are asked to complete the following:

- **Application Fee:** Payable when submitting the online application. This must be settled before your child's test and interview.
- **Deposit and Legacy Fund:** A contract is issued to formalise the offer of a place at the school. The deposit and legacy fund invoice is sent with the contract.
- **Tuition & Boarding Fees:** The first semester's tuition and boarding fee are invoiced in March for students commencing their studies in August.
- **Additional Expenses**
Billed in February and July, in the same way as for returning families.
Invoice payments are due within 30 days of receipt of invoice. Full payment is required to guarantee enrolment.

Returning Families: For students who are already enrolled at Lyceum Alpinum Zuoz:

- **Tuition & Boarding Fees:** Invoices are issued twice a year, in May and December.
- **Additional Expenses:** Billed in February and July.
Full payment of the invoice is due within 30 days of receipt of invoice.

Payment Method: All payments are made by bank transfer (see details below). Please note that cash payments are not accepted.

Insurance

Accident and health insurance

Provision of accident and health insurance cover is the responsibility of the parents. Parents domiciled within Switzerland or the European Union are required to provide evidence of insurance cover for their child(ren). The insurance policy must provide cover during school and holiday/leisure time and include cover for student activities, cricket, Fives, skiing, ice skating (incl. ice hockey), tobogganing, guided mountain tours, and other school events.

Students without an accident/health insurance policy recognised in Switzerland can join the collective insurance policy of the Lyceum Alpinum Zuoz. Please complete the relevant section of the registration form. (Collective health and accident insurance policy ÖKK St. Moritz, monthly premium approx. CHF 150. The insurance company reserves the right to adjust the rates.)

Cover provided by the Lyceum Alpinum Zuoz combined accident and health insurance policy is obligatory for children whose parents reside outside Switzerland or the European Union. Upon signature of the school registration form appropriate cover will be arranged automatically by the school with the ÖKK St. Moritz. The general contractual conditions of our insurance policy apply.

Private third-party liability insurance

The Lyceum Alpinum insures all boarding students with the personal liability insurance policy of Axa Winterthur. They are insured against liability arising from their behaviour in everyday life (personal liability). The maximum sum for damages to persons and property is CHF 5,000,000 with a personal waiver of CHF 200 per event. The general (AVB) and special (BVB) terms of Axa Winterthur apply (Policy no. 4.594.934).

Corporate Liability Insurance

The current liability insurance of the school covers personal items that students have brought to the school (including items that students have deposited at the school) against the risks of destruction, damage, theft or loss. The insurance cover does not extend to valuables (e.g. jewellery), money or paper securities. The maximum sum insured amounts to CHF 3,000 per student and liability event, the deductible amounting to CHF 100.

Enrolment Regulations

New student enrolment:

A student's admission is confirmed once the School Contract has been signed by all parties. If the signed contract is not returned within two weeks, the Lyceum Alpinum Zuoz is no longer bound by the terms of the original offer.

Withdrawal Before School Commencement

- Before 15 May, parents may withdraw without cost, except the Application Fee and the Legacy Fund.
- Withdrawal between 15 May and 15 June: 50% of the Deposit is forfeited.
- After 15 June: 100% of the Deposit is forfeited.

Leaving the School

- Boarding is integral: students may not continue at the school without residing in the boarding house.
- Notice must be given in writing by registered post to the Head of School:
 - By 31 October for withdrawal at the end of Semester 1.
 - By 28 February for withdrawal at the end of the school year.
- If notice is late, contractual obligations and costs remain for the following semester.
- Exceptions: Students not promoted may withdraw without notice. Graduating students remain under contract until the end of the school year. Special permission is required to remain in boarding after final exams.

Expulsion

Students may be expelled at any time for disciplinary reasons. If the grounds for expulsion arise after May 15 for the First Semester or after October 30 for the Second Semester, the Parents will be liable for the fees for both the current semester and the following semester. This applies regardless of the reason of the expulsion and regardless of whether the Parents or the Student of age of majority deem the expulsion justified, as it is necessary to cover Lyceum Alpinum's financial commitments and the impact of the Student's removal.

Absences & Premature Departure

- No refund is given for absences (illness, study abroad, etc.), as school and boarding places must be retained.
- Upon request, reductions to meal costs may be granted for absences exceeding four weeks.
