We would like to recommend that you personally bring your child/children to the Lyceum Alpinum Zuoz on the first day. It will give you the chance to meet Mr Shuler and the teachers.

Morning lessons

The language courses are taught by teachers from the academia-group Zurich. We no longer ask the children to complete a language test in advance. Instead, the language teachers will assess each participant on the first morning and make classes according to their level.

Afternoon programme

A detailed weekly programme will be sent to you 10 days before the start of the Junior Day Camp.

Pick-up service

Every morning, we will pick up your child/children from the selected pick-up point and bring them to the school. **Please [log into your child's account and fill in the necessary information, if you wish to book this service](#)**. 10 days before the Junior Day Camp starts, we will send you the pick-up/drop-off schedule for your child/children. The pick-up/drop-off schedule may change on a daily basis.

We do not offer a shuttle service to school on the first Monday morning of each week. This service will start every Monday at 4:00 pm, and the service is free of charge.

Clothing and school materials

Zuoz is located at 1,750 metres above sea level and enjoys a sunny high-alpine climate.

The following clothing is essential:

- sneakers
- hat
- sunglasses
- sun cream
- raincoat
- fleece pullover

We will provide the necessary school material.

All children will receive a Lyceum Alpinum Zuoz t-shirt, cap, water bottle, and a backpack.

Regulations/Conduct

Our school reserves the right to send home anyone whose behaviour is incompatible with our school rules.

We kindly remind parents that children attending the Junior Day Camp do not need a smartphone. Please **do not** provide one.

Insurance coverage

The Lyceum Alpinum Zuoz does not offer insurance coverage. Parents are responsible for organising suitable health and accident insurance as well as third party liability cover for the period of their child's stay in Zuoz, including their travelling time to and from Zuoz.

Medical information

Our nurse will be available around the clock. If your child/children have something, we will contact you immediately. In serious cases, we will take your child/children to the regional hospital in Samedan.
